Climate & Emissions Reporting

Scope 1, 2 and 3 emissions quantification and climate-related financial disclosure under Australia's mandatory reporting regime, including the governance frameworks and board reporting needed to meet director sign-off and assurance requirements.

02 For Delivery & Operational Teams

For the teams running the project day to day: project leaders, commercial leaders and site leads carrying the contracts, schedules and the work of actually building and running the asset.

Commercial & Contracts

EPC, OEM, BOP, PPA and grid connection negotiation; contract structuring, offtake arrangements and dispute resolution across the project lifecycle.

Project Management

Development through to financial close including feasibility, approvals, financial modelling and execution planning.

Construction Management

On-the-ground delivery leadership, EPC oversight, HSEQ and regulatory compliance, and commissioning through to commercial operation.

Asset Management

Post-COD governance and performance oversight, the ongoing stewardship that keeps infrastructure assets performing across their operating life.
